Training on livelihoods has been conducted, along with natural farming techniques vermi culture has been introduced to the people in the village. A business plan will be made for them to make sure that the enterprises that they have started will be systematic and financially stable.

Awareness program on rights and entitlements. Awareness on sustainable livelihood opportunities and awareness on government schemes and support was given to the people from time to time. They need to be aware so that they can prepare for the future.

They have first-hand witnessed the training on sustainable livelihood given to the family of Mr. John Paul a boy with multiple disabilities. Later they donated to us medicine and clothes so we could distribute those to the families in the villages.



Learn to Run



Ms. Kerlinda War traveled to Pune to attend a 2 days workshop organized by KNOCK India on how to run an Organisation. coming back she truly believed that she could make further changes in the organization to work for the vulnerable people in the society. The workshop has taught her how to raise funds using the strength of the community and to also connect with different people to strengthen the organisation further.





FIELD INTERVENTION

Meetings with our Primary Stakeholders at the border of Bangladesh, At the same time awareness was being raised to the people, on disability issues and their entitlements and rights. An assessment camp will be organized again in Sohra Town where those without their disability certificate can visit the center and be certified to attain their rights and entitlements.







As part of the early childhood development programs, the team has created a session at a home base level where the mother will make homemade toys with their child. In the activities, young teens were involved in volunteering to make toys and Innovative material. The toys are used to support the development of young children in terms of gross and fine motor skills, cognition skills, and social skills.
