Celebrating the International Day for Persons with Disabilities Marvelling Roots in collaboration with Bethany Society, Maraikaphon Dorbar, Nohkalikai Village and Mawkisyiem Seng Samla had organised a one-day Blind Football match. Blind football, also known as "football 5-a-side," is an incredible sport where visually impaired athletes showcase their skills. A tournament with four teams participating would likely be an intense and fascinating event. The four teams are Mawkisyiem Seng Samla, Maraikaphon Under 21 football club, Nohkalikai Sengsamla, and Meghalaya Blind football team. Out of all the four teams, only the Meghalaya Blind football team has players who are visually impaired (Blind).

The players from the other three teams are blindfolded, relying on their hearing and the sound of the ball (which contains bells) to orient themselves. The goalkeeper is sighted and acts as a guide to direct their teammates during the game. The setup for a blind football match involves a smaller, enclosed field with sideboards that keep the ball in play.

INCLUSION

The final match was being played against Maraikaphon Under 21 Football Club and Meghalaya Blind Football Team. It was an exciting moment in both the teams scored 1 goal each during the normal time. The match was later taken to extra time in which none of them were able to shake the net. The match was taken to a tie-breaker in which most of the Marai Kaphon Players failed to score and the Meghalaya blind football team was able to score 3 goals during the tie-breaker which took the Meghalaya football team to claim the victory in this exciting and wonderful event. The program was later concluded with a prize, certificate, and momentos distribution followed by a short speech by the Rangbah Shnong of Marai Kaphon, Sengsamla mawkisyiem and Nohkalikai Headman. special thanks go to our generous supporters and well wishers in making this event a success.
